Fibre Systems recommend regular cleaning of all external and internal surfaces of your shower to avoid a build up of dirt which can damage the product and shorten the life of your shower.

- Solvents



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

SHOWER TRAYS AND WALL LININGS

Fibre System's manufacture Shower Trays and Wall Liners using premium quality sanitaryware grade Acrylic. This is a non-porous material.

Cleaning of these surfaces is easy with just a non abrasive cloth and soapy water.

Regular cleaning is advised to prevent build up of soap, scum, and body oils on the surface.

Additionally our Shower Trays feature a solid acrylic surface layer allowing small scratches to be removed with a cutting compound and polish. If severe damage occurs, in many cases our Shower Trays can also be professionally repaired.



SHOWER GLASS AND FRAMING

All Shower Glass is compliant to AS/NZS 2208. Glass surface should be wiped down or squeegeed and framing should be wiped down after every use to remove excess water and prevent staining and lime scale buildup. Lime scale build over time is very difficult to remove. On Glass surfaces some lime scale removers can be used, but must only be applied to the glass.

To prohibit Limescale build up, Black Framed Showers should be wiped down and dried after every use, without exception

Our framed sliding door showers also feature easy-release rollers, which aid cleaning between the glass and framework, these should be disengaged and cleaned on a monthly basis .

Weatherseals and drips strips can be removed for cleaning and can be replaced when no longer looking their best. Refer to the spare parts area in our website for details.



BATHS AND BATH LININGS

Fibre System's manufacture baths and linings from the same material as our Shower Trays and Wall Linings so cleaning methods are the same.



SHOWER ACCESSORIES

Fibre System's range of Shower Accessories are manufactured from a wide range of corrosion resistant material, cleaning these surfaces should only require soapy water and a non abrasive cloth.

Removable inserts and glass shelves are NOT DISHWASHER safe and should be cleaned with soapy water and a non abrasive cloth.
